



About the Jarl....

This years jarl is Euan Henderson from Gloup. Euan is portraying Floke Vilgerdersson also known as Ramna Flokki.

Euan is the first person to be a third generation jarl. His Grandfather Willie Barclay was Jarl in 1958, the first year that the festival was held in Cullivoe. In his memory Euan has named his Galley "Sigr" which is the same name as his grandfather used. It means "Victory". His late father John was Jarl in 1965. It has always been Euan's desire to have a Gloup orientated Jarl squad but sadly after the passing of his father this could no longer be a reality. He is more than proud to be Jarl and is a very fitting man for the job.

Up-Helly-Aa has always meant a lot to Euan. It was the biggest event in the year for him and probably still is. He used to look forward to the Jarl Squad (with their Cadburys Cream Eggs) coming to the school when he was in primary. Euan started in the school squad in 1984 when the late George Gunn was Jarl. He was in that squad until he went to the Mid Yell School when he then joined a squad that his brother Adrian, Tim Fraser, Jason Stanley and Peerie John Henderson were in. This squad became known as the Gloup squad with members coming and going over the years, but the original three of Euan, Adrian and John has never changed.

Euan has some very memorable moments of his involvement in Up-Helly-Aa but none more so as the yearly "torch makin". He has been subject to many a prank in the Galley Shed, one year he was nailed to the floor. He has also had to return home to Gloup from torch makings in the early hours of a frosty morning wearing nothing more than a Big Daddy suit.

Euan has always been heavily involved in Up-Helly-Aa but even more so when he became age to drive. He, along with his brother, was among the first at the Galley Shed on Up-Helly-Aa morning to help take the Galley out with the Chief Marshall Geordie Henry. After the Jarl Squad have visited to the school, Euan would help move the torches from the Galley shed to Willie Anderson's garage. Now they are moved to Arthur Albutt's garage for the new procession route.

He is normally MC at the Hop concert but due to being in the Jarl Squad has taken a few years out. He has also been a regular item in the hop concert either singing or performing in sketches. Another highlight of UHA is the hop day dinners. Euan has acted as courier on the bus back to Cullivoe, which has caused many a laugh.

Euan has asked Martin Henderson to succeed him as Jarl in 2010.

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The Jarl Squad

Euan Henderson: The Jarl this year goes under the name "Floke Vilgerdersson".
