year and when they leave school wish to carry on squadding, either by joining one of the established squads or setting up one of their own.

This is only my second year in the Galley Shed, my first being last year as Jarl-Elect in David Spence's squad, and I have really enjoyed the experience, despite being a bit apprehensive about getting everything ready in time. I am very grateful for all the help given and offered by members of the community.

Finally, I want to thank Susan, for putting up with me after late nights at the Galley Shed and for her work helping make the outfits for the bairns and the squad. Also thanks go to our three lasses Lana, Emma and Katy for their ideas and enthusiasm. On behalf of us all and the squad I would like to thank Christine Brown, Amber Halcrow, Lee Leaper, Jean Saunders and all the squad members' partners, the galley builders as well as everyone else who does so much over the weekend to help make Up Helly Aa happen.


Saturday 28th February

The Saga of Ragnar Lodbrok

Ragnar Lodbrok (Ragnar Hairy Breeches) was a legendary Norse ruler and hero from the Viking Age, who is described in Old Norse poetry and several sagas. According to legend, Ragnar was the scourge of France and England and the father of many renowned sons, including Ivar the Boneless, Björn Ironside, Halfdan Ragnarsson, Sigurd Snake-in-the-Eye, and Ubba. Many of the tales about him appear to originate with the deeds of historical Viking heroes and rulers.

Said to have been a relative of the Danish king Gudfred and son of the Swedish king Sigurd Hring, he became king and distinguished himself through many raids and conquests. He was eventually seized by his foe, King Ælla of Northumbria, and killed by being thrown into a pit of snakes. His sons bloodily avenged him by invading England with the Great Heathen Army.





Up Helly Aa 1970

Below is the full report from Cullivoe Up Helly Aa when John's father Andrew was Guizer Jarl. Published on 20th February 1970, it is reprinted here with kind permission from *The Shetland Times*:

WIND AND SNOW FOR CULLIVOE FESTIVAL

"Cullivoe Up Helly Aa was celebrated on Thursday 12th February, despite a strong northerly wind and frequent showers making conditions blizzard-like. The festival was as successful as ever, and the best financially since the formation of the Up Helly Aa Committee ten years ago. When the squads were doing their stunts and at the dance which followed, there was a full house in the Cullivoe Hall.

The guizers mustered at Burnside and after Guizer Jarl Andrew Williamson had boarded his longship *Sae Orn* the torches were lit and, amid drifting snow and freezing cold, the procession of guizers moved off along the usual route to the burning site near the hall.

Under such weather conditions it was no pleasure for spectators to watch the procession nor the burning, so they were admitted to the hall where, in due course, they were addressed by the Guizer Jarl, after which he announced the first squad to perform and after the departure of the last squad he read the telegrams. At the dance which followed he was M.C. and carried out his duties very ably. Dancing continued till the sma' 'oors of Friday morning and everyone present had a very enjoyable time.

There was a decrease in the number of squads this year, but those that did turn up gave an excellent show. The snow resulted in the cancellation of a squad from Lerwick comprising seventeen guizers.

THE SQUADS

1. GUIZER JARL'S SQUAD (5) - The members of this squad were resplendent in Viking attire.

2. LUNAR SAPHARIE (6) - This stunt was based on the moon landing by man. Two space crafts supposedly to be landing on the moon arrived, out of which came four astronauts. After an inspection of the lunar surface and an interception of two lunar animals who didn't seem very happy about Man's presence, the four entered their space crafts and departed.

3. NASTY NAUGHTY NETTERS (9) - A recent local poaching case sparked this one off with its members appearing in the roles of the people who were involved in the original case. After the judge had heard the evidence given by witnesses involved and thoroughly questioned the accused he found them to be guilty on all charges and imposed fines up to £25.
